- Application form and eligibility, programme fee information can be seen on the university website www.ksrdpru.ac.in. Candidates shall apply in the online portal of the University and shall pay application fee online or submit application personally in the admission office of the University. Candidates applying for more than one programme should apply separately for each programme and pay the application fees for each of the programmes applied for. The application fees for General / OBC category candidates is Rs.300/- and for SC / ST / Cat-1 / Disabled Candidates is Rs.150/-.
- The candidates who have submitted online applications have to download their application copy along with the uploaded photocopies (one set) of all the academic and other documents and send to "The Registrar, MGRDPR University, Koushalya Vikas Bhavan, Grama Gangothri Campus, Nagavi," either in person or speed post or by courier, on or before 31-08-2026.
- As per the Government Order No. ಗ್ರಾಉಪ 301 ಜಿಪಸ 2017, ದಿನಾಂಕ: 17-10-2017, the eligible "In-service Candidates" of the Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department, Government of Karnataka, may also submit their applications for the PG Programmes offered in the MGRDPR University, Gadag, and as per this Government Order (please visit the University website) TWO (2) in-service candidates for each PG Programme are eligible to take admission. There is No Concession in fees i.e. application fee, admission fee, hostel fee, etc., for the in-service candidates and the applications have to be submitted through the proper official channel.
